
# **TinyExplorer** Recording Instructions

### Recording

#### Please record at home on a usual day during playtime:

- · When your child is at their best, and outside of meal and nap times.
- · As soon as possible, as the battery life will start depleting.
- Take the TinyExplorer gear and activity 1 diary out of the grey bag.

## Need to pause the recording?

Please try to avoid pausing the recording as much as possible.

However, if at any point you want to pause the recording, please follow these steps:

- Press the white button once and wait for the 1 camera to stop flashing red. The camera is now paused.
  - Press again to re-start the recording (it will start flashing red again once recording).

#### **Useful Tips**

to get the TinyExplorer gear on

You know best what works for your child, but here are a few tips that have worked for other families:

- Try placing the gear on in one swift, confident movement.
- · Distract your child perhaps with their favourite toy, or food.
- Put on a short clip of your child's favourite TV show.
- Try again after a nap or a meal.
- · Put a normal hat on your child's head for a few hours, so they get used to the feeling.
- Try placing the gear on the top of your head, to show your child what it looks like.
- · Some children enjoy seeing what they look like in the mirror.
- If your child enjoys wearing a bike helmet, you could try to call this gear a helmet.
- · Perhaps try another day sometimes sleep can make all the difference.
